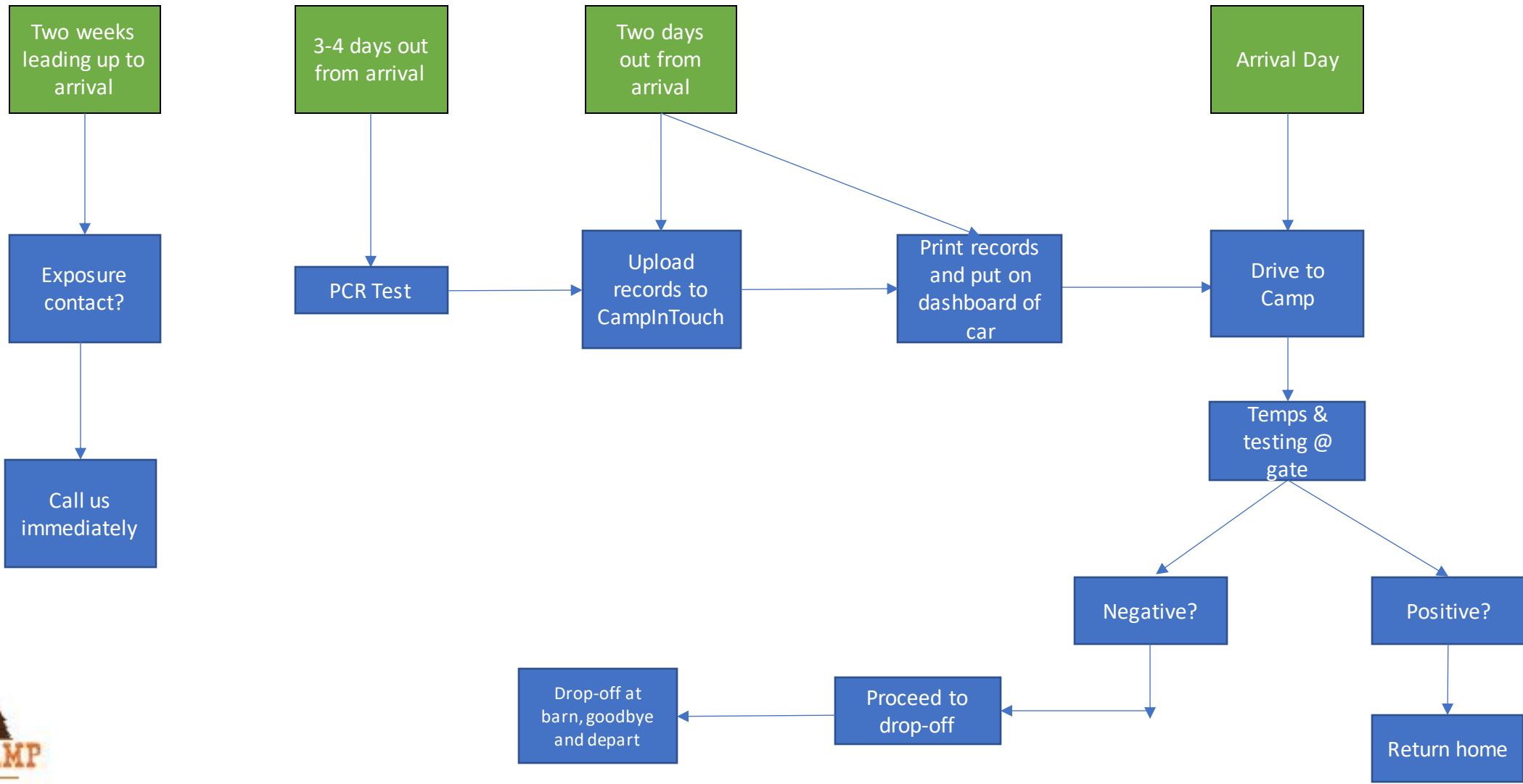

WELCOME: Katelyn

- Katelyn Skeen: New Assistant Director
 - MESH Initiative @ Camp
 - You'll be hearing from her a lot
 - Leading our admin (camper care/UH) team, directly, during the summer

I.C.Y.M.I

- No DJDS shuttle – driving to camp
- While at camp, parents must remain masked and with their vehicle
- First 72-hours at camp: exclusively in bunk cohorts
- Pre-arrival testing, arrival screening, pre-trip testing
- Campers flying in – more info to come!
 - Extended cancellation policy for campers traveling from a primary residence out of state
 - Likely requiring specific masks for airplane travel
 - Easy ID bag tags – bags picked up by non-camp personnel and brought to camp separately.



GOLDEN RULES

1. If you are indoors, with others, outside your cohort, you are masked.
2. If you are outdoors, with your cohort, you may be unmasked unless you cannot maintain appropriate physical distance from a program staff or other person not in your cohort.

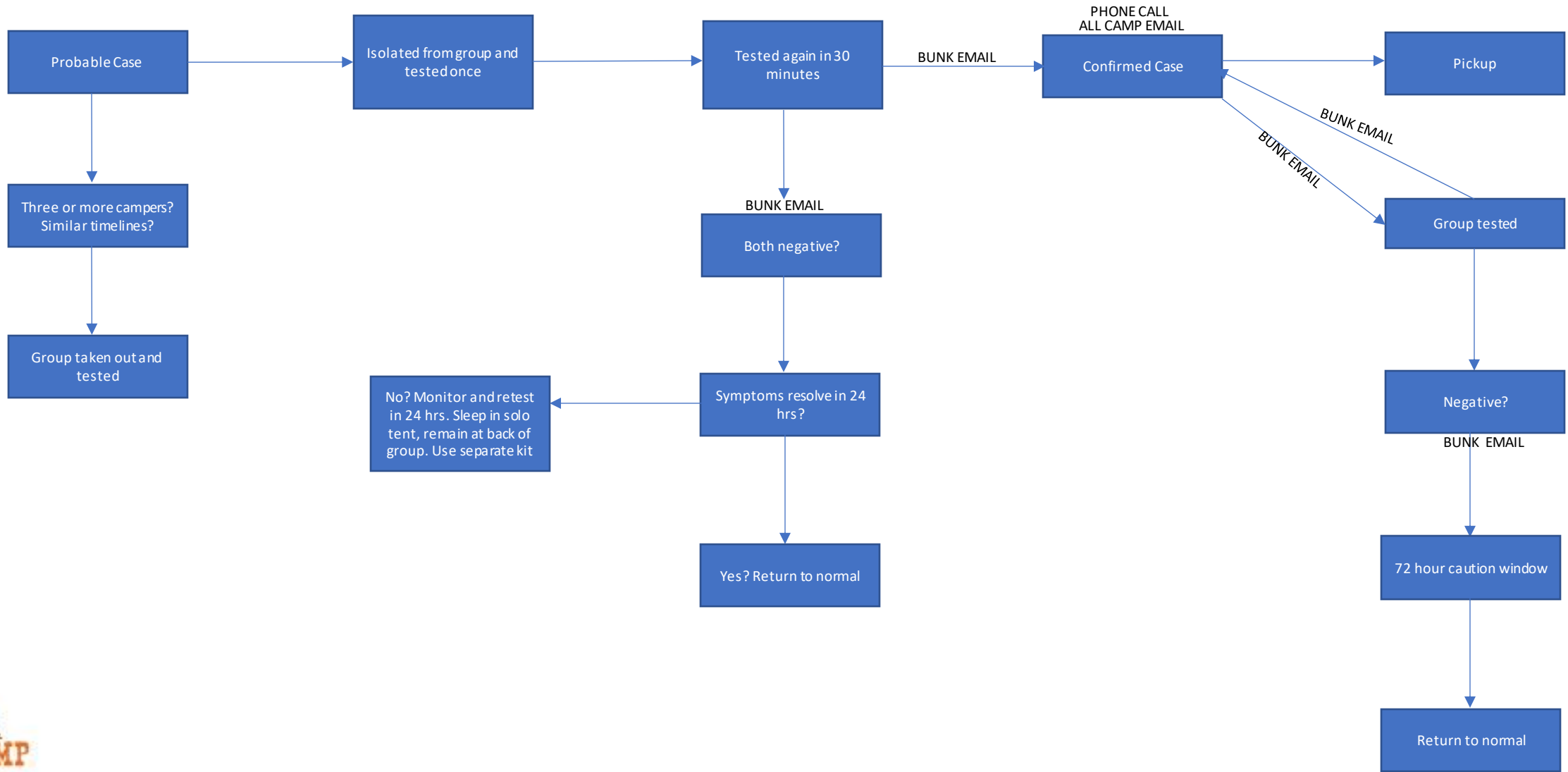


TRIP LIFE

- Bus sanitized before departure
- NEW: TASC/TV/P&R – Masks worn on bus
- Food drop!
- Public area stops limited. Masks required in any public spaces.
 - Daily checks of county COVID dials – avoiding areas where dial is going up
- Groups in cohorts upon return to camp
- Masks!

ON TRIP: POSITIVE & SUSPECTED CASES

- COVID Practice Agreement
- Probable case – camper rapid tested, 2x, 30 minutes apart
 - Positive? Group is taken to testing center
 - TASC – Chaffee County Medical Center
 - TV - Walgreens Testing Center – (Pueblo) - La Plata Community Testing Facility (Durango) - Walgreens Testing Center (Telluride) - Chaffee County Medical Center (Buena Vista)
 - P&R – CSU Equine Center & Ranch Event Complexes
 - Extra single-person tents – sleeping spots for campers who become symptomatic
 - Negative results + symptom Resolution? Return to normal in 24 hours.
- Confirmed case – need to be picked up within 24 hours
 - Current practice for out of state campers: 72 hours
- 3 kids with symptoms? Same timeline? Hike out, test.



POSITIVE TESTS - FINANCES

If your camper is sent home more than three days from the end of the session, you are eligible for up to 40% pro-rated credit towards 2022

COMMUNICATION

- Daily trip update – approximate location and GPS ping if available
- 24 hours after return, BUT before 48 – individual camper updates
- Photos will not and cannot be posted until the group has returned and is debriefed, showered & rested
- Photos can't be posted from the wilderness
- Photos can't be posted from the bus
- There's no internet in the woods

EMERGENCY COMMUNICATION

- Trip to doctor? Need to come off trail? Always a call.
- Positive case on trip?
 - Direct email to trip families
 - Discreet e-mail to all families
 - Immediate phone call, from me, to affected family
- Trips same as years past – Satellite phone & SPOT device
 - Same procedures as on-site emergency communication

CURRENT: 2021 PACKING ADDENDUM

- Multiple, reusable, double-layered masks for campers and staff
- **Multiple, multiple, multiple** masks. Everyone.
 - We will also be providing disposable masks
- One box/bag of 25 disposable masks
- One Crazy Creek camping chair
- One hard plastic shower caddy
- Delicates bag for mask washing
- Ranch: Not providing sleeping bags for overnights
- Labeled bottles: sunscreen & hand sanitizer
